He is the owner of Eaglestar Enterprises Ltd. A company that specializes in Cultural consultant work for all industries.

He's currently under contract with TSUUT'INA Nation and Alberta Health services as a Cultural Helper. He helps hospital patients get back to health with traditional knowledge of herbs and ceremony.

Hal is also a Master of Ceremonies for First Nation pow-wow's and Round Dance celebrations across North America. He also facilitates conferences and workshops.

He has traveled international taking Native dance troupe's to help educate and promote First Nations history and cultural identity. He's traveled to New Zealand, Switzerland, Germany, France and England. In 2007 he was asked by the Alberta Government to represent First Nations of Alberta at the Smithsonian Folklife festival in Washington DC on Historical Evolution of Alberta's Native Peoples.
